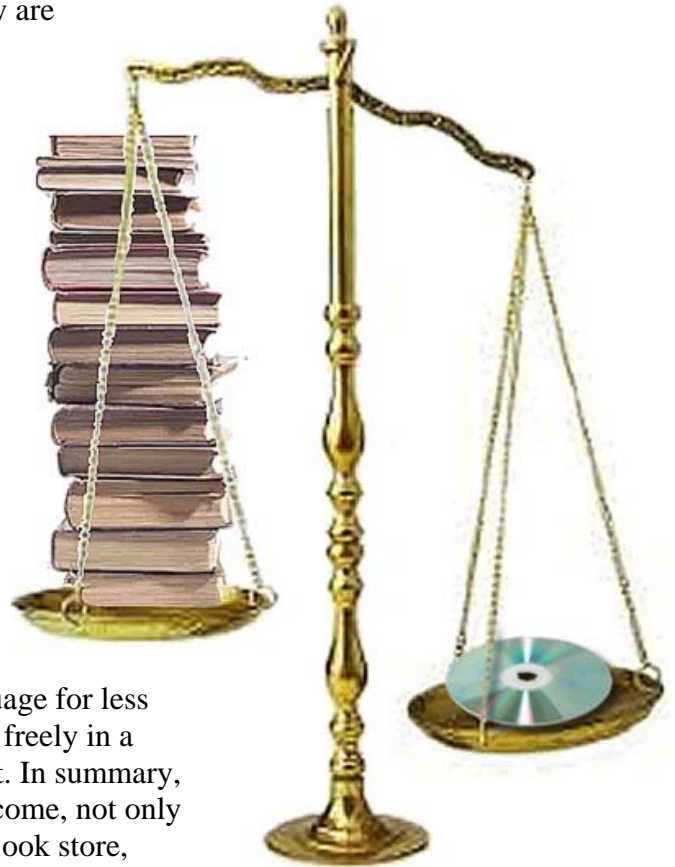

Digital Bible Society Summary

The unprecedented growth of worldwide computer distribution is no secret. In September 2002, the one billionth computer was manufactured. The feat took twenty five years, but it is estimated that the second billionth computer will be built by the year 2008, with the majority of those being distributed in Asia, Latin America and the Middle East.

Meanwhile, huge segments of the world community are still without Bibles and Christian literature. Some estimate that, in China alone, more than 40 million Christians still do not possess a Bible they can call their own. In Arabic nations, Christian literature is outlawed, yet personal computers are welcomed. The Digital Bible Society believes that just as God used the Guttenberg printing press to distribute Bibles and Reformation literature in the 15th century, God is likewise using the personal computer to make the Scriptures available worldwide.

New technologies are changing the face of missions and resource distribution. Traditionally, Bibles have cost missionary societies several dollars to produce and distribute. Now, a massive multimedia Christian library, a resource normally costing thousands of dollars, can be reproduced on a single computer disk (CD), in one's own language for less than 40¢. Moreover, that same "CD" can be copied freely in a matter of minutes and carried away in one's pocket. In summary, one Bible CD enables any personal computer to become, not only a comprehensive Bible study tool, but a Christian Book store, Bible distribution center and Gospel printing press as well.



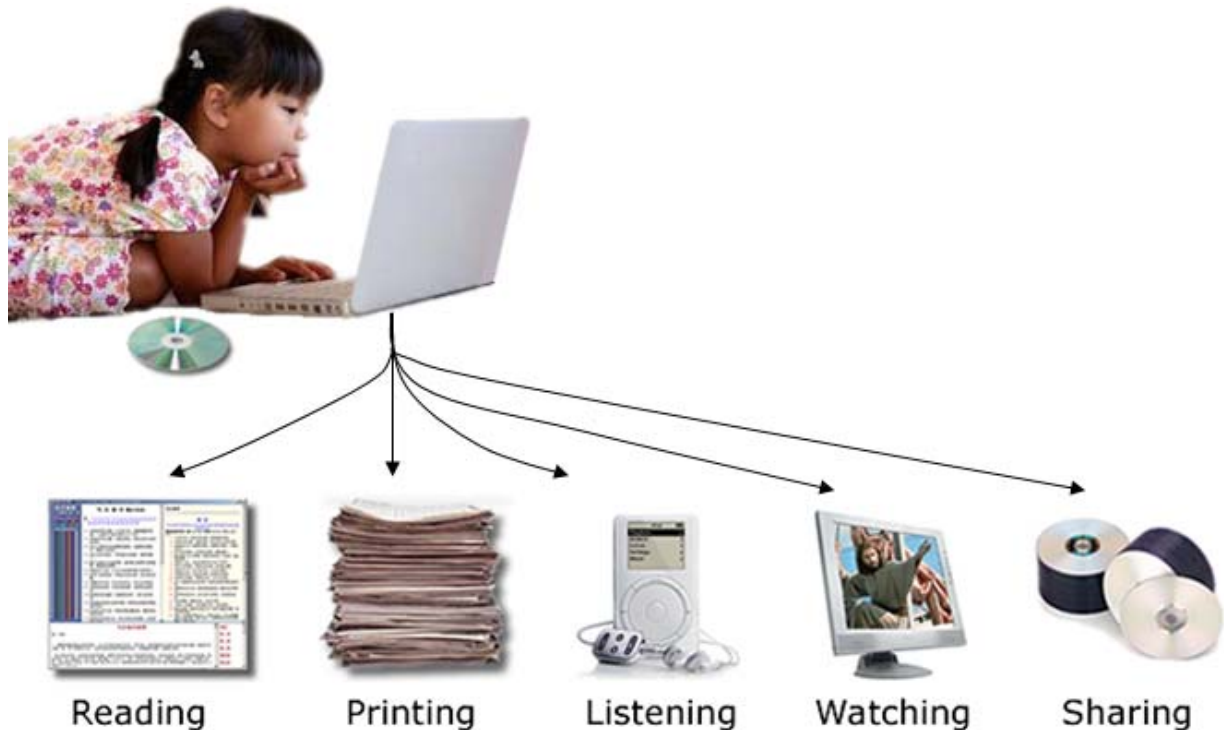
We believe that such developments present unprecedented opportunity for the edification of the church and evangelization of the lost - especially with regards to closed and persecuted nations.

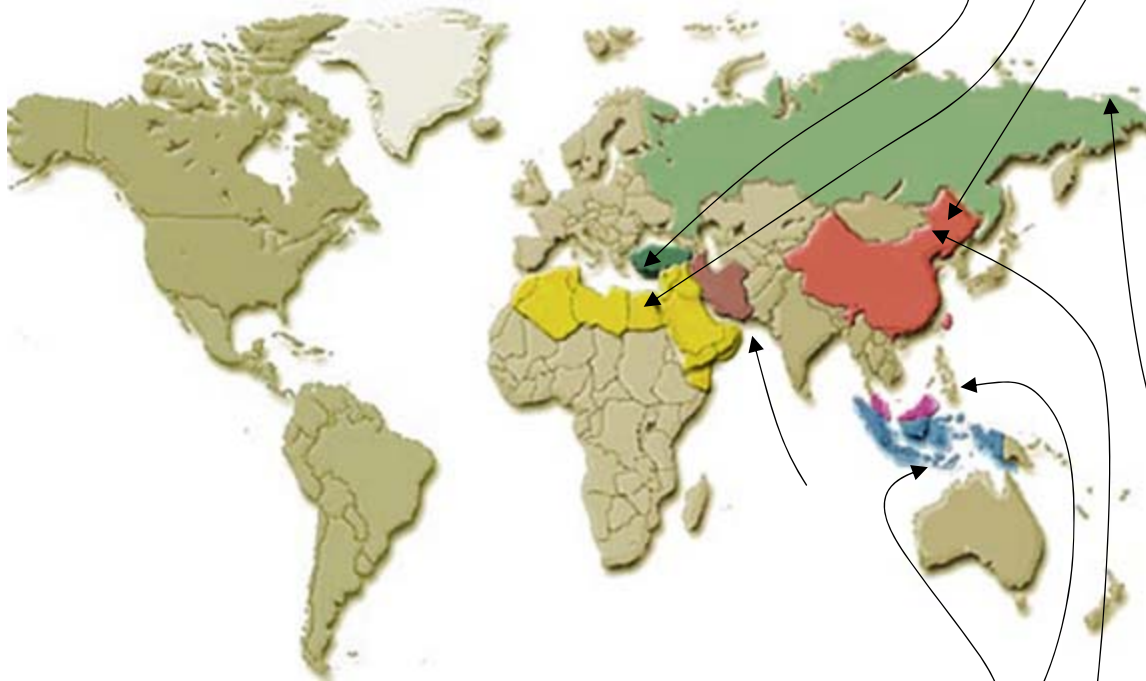
